Introduction:

WHA72.6 global action on patient safety has been approved in 2019 requests the Member States for promoting a patient safety culture. Organizational culture determines the success of its patient safety initiatives, and the periodic analysis and review of the survey outcomes will be utilized to build robust action plans that will lead to enhance patient safety.

Description:

This is a focused training session that will emphasize assessing assigned leaders and quality and patient safety directors within participated countries on how to be prepared well for the development and implementation of the survey at a national level, enhance staff engagement, highlighting the priorities and Areas for improvements, building action plans, using targeted interventions, and monitoring the success and improvement in existing perceived safety culture.

- 1.To assist in the development and implementation of national initiatives for measuring and enhancing perceived safety culture within hospitals.
2. To establish and maintain a high-level engagement with quality and patient safety experts and leaders within Pakistan.
- 3.To promote patient safety culture and raise awareness.
- 4.To recommend strategies towards better staff engagement
- 5.To assist in building proper and effective action plans that will lead to enhance patient safety.
